

ARKANSAS BLACK APPLE



USES: Eating, cooking, juice, hard cider. Its aromatic juice lends itself very well to cider and jams.

FLAVOR: Highly aromatic with a sweet tart flavor.

CHARACTERISTICS: Medium size; skin color red and/or purple to nearly black; flesh color is cream with a fine grained and crisp texture.

RIPENING: middle of fall to early winter.

ORIGINATED: in Wisconsin in 1840; a relative of the Winesap family.
