



NORTHWEST GREENING



USES: Cooking and baking

CHARACTERISTICS: Medium to large; a yellow-green sphere with slightly raised lenticels, some russeted to brown. The flesh is very light yellow with green highlights.

FLAVOR: It is medium, fine-grained and a bit dry. The greenish yellow flesh is firm, crisp and dense and juicy with a little give to the tooth, flavor is mildly tart with hints of citrus and pear.

RIPENING: Late September/early October.

HISTORY: Originated in Wisconsin in 1872, a Golden Russett-Alexander cross.
