



TURBAN SQUASH



Named for its shape, Turban Squash has colors that vary from bright orange to green and white. It has golden-yellow flesh, and its taste is reminiscent of hazelnut.

It has a bulb-like cap swelling from its blossom end, comes in bizarre shapes with extravagant coloration that makes it popular as a harvest ornamental. It is popular for centerpieces and, after removing the top and hollowing out, makes a lovely soup tureen.

A larger variety of the Buttercup Squash, the Turban has a bright orange-red rind. Its flesh and storage ability are comparable to the Buttercup.
